	 Requests from students on uniform: Students would like to be allowed to have sensible piercings in nose and ears. Black trainers with some white on. Proper ties Skinny trousers School jumpers as an alternative to a blazer More flexibility in PE kit e.g. tracksuits CR to feedback to SLT.

Ideas for form time were as follows: class discussions around current topics weekly themes e.g. maths going outside in good weather time in computer suites to research apprenticeships and careers (Y10 &11) Action: CR to distribute minutes to HoY to plan character curriculum
AOB	Students feel that cancelling non-school uniform because when litter is bad is not fair on those students who do not drop litter. They have asked that we consider having litter monitors who report litterers for detentions. Mr Cholerton suggested that we could have non-school uniform only for pupils who arrived at school on time. Action CR to take to SLT. Students from Y9 have requested hot drinks at break.
