I am delighted and very proud with the examination grades that our year 11 students have achieved and been awarded this year. I would like to say well done and congratulations to the whole school community.

I am particularly delighted that the vast majority of our students have been successful in securing their preferred post 16 pathway, which in these difficult times is a phenomenal achievement. The whole of CODA wishes all of our students the very best in their next stages of life.

The results that our students have achieved are our best ever and continue to demonstrate the continuing improvements CODA is making. 43% of our students achieved a grade 4 or above in both English and mathematics and 22% have achieved a grade 5 or above in both English and mathematics. This is another improvement from the previous year.

I am especially proud that 22 different students achieved the top grade of a 9 in a number of subjects. Also, 46 students achieved at least one grade 7 or above, this is over one quarter of the year group.
