Year 11 & Post 16 students have been invited to apply for Level 3 apprenticeships

They offer a 4-year programme designed to give practical on the job training in Fleet Engineering depots, combined with classroom-based learning that will give all the underpinning knowledge needed to be successful in apprenticeships.

All you need is GCSE's at a grade 4 or above (or A* - C if received in 2017 or earlier) in English, Maths and Science. They welcome candidates from all backgrounds. Women and ethnic minority groups are currently under-represented within our Fleet Engineering population and are encouraged to apply. They value diversity and are committed to ensuring equality across our organisation.

How does the partnership work?

Our partner company apprenticeships mean employment is with a chosen partner company (above) from the very beginning ('home company'). However, training takes place within our Apprentice Development Centre, here on site at Toyota, Burnaston.

Our partner companies are a range of engineering firms from around the local area, who are looking for Maintenance Apprentices to join their business.

The apprenticeship is 44 months long, and apprentices would gain a level 3 maintenance engineering qualification at the end of this.

The first two years of the apprenticeship will be taught at Toyota with some placement weeks at the home company.

The final two years of the apprenticeship is mainly based at the home company with some occasional training at Toyota.

To be eligible to apply you must possess or be anticipating a minimum of 4 GCSE passes at grade 4/C or above, including Maths, Science and English. **Closing date for applications is 11/04/21**

Once trained you will be required to service, repair and improve the performance of all manufacturing equipment, analysing faults and providing a solution in a safe and timely manner to maximise machine up time.

What Will You Do?

Stage 1 – For your first 2 years, you will be based in the Toyota Academy, Burnaston, you will cover subjects such as electricity, electronics, welding, machining, control systems and hydraulics.

Stage 2 – Your second two years will be spent in a maintenance team within Radius Systems, Hilcote, practically learning how to apply your new skills, and how to safely maintain Radius's plant and systems
