- Face coverings The government has removed the requirement to wear face masks in law but expects and recommends that they are worn in enclosed and crowded spaces where individuals may come into contact with people they do not normally meet. This includes public transport and dedicated transport to school or college. As a school we have made the decision to allow students and staff to wear face masks if they wish to whilst in school.
