As a reminder:

- <u>1</u>. <u>Lateral Flow Tests</u> can we please remind all parents to encourage their child(ren) to complete two lateral flow tests per week. Knowing that the students attending school have a low viral load is important for everyone's safety
- <u>2.</u> <u>COVID-19 vaccinations</u> COVID-19 vaccinations for 12-15 year olds will take place at CoDA on Thursday 11th November 2021. Thank you to those parents who have already booked a vaccination appointment for their child(dren). If you have not yet booked an appointment but would still like to please follow the link <u>https://www.derbyshireandcityimms.co.uk/Forms/Covid</u> and complete the online form. - 3. Additional Preventative Measures in place include
 - a. Regular sanitising
 - b. Keeping to the left when moving around school
 - c. Staff and students have the option to wear face coverings.
 - d. Well-ventilated rooms
 - e. If your child displays signs of the COVID-19 symptoms or receives a positive lateral flow test result, please keep them at home and request a PCR test via the NHS Test & Trace service.

We are monitoring the cases daily. If cases increase significantly we will have to put contingency measures in place which may include mandatory face coverings for all, 'zoning' students at break and lunch time and staggering the entrances and exits before and after the school day.
