Dear Parents/carers,

As the first half term of 2022 comes to an end, I would like to thank you all for supporting your child's education and working hard to keep Covid-19 cases low.

The Prime Minister has announced that the planned removal of Covid-19 restrictions, originally scheduled for the end of March, will be brought forward. Although some of the Covid-19 procedures we have implemented have had beneficial impacts on the elements of school life, we are now looking forward to returning to CODA's pre-pandemic culture and expectations. Therefore, I am writing to you all to announce that from Monday the 14th of March 2022 the expectations at CODA will return to where they were before the pandemic. Uniform Expectations

Students who have PE on their time table will now be getting changed in the PE changing rooms. As a further reminder, hoodies, non-school uniform jumpers, jeans, trainers, nose rings are not part of the school uniform.
