#### Why study a foreign language ?

Through studying a GCSE in a modern foreign language, students should

develop their ability and ambition to communicate with native speakers in speech

and writing. The study of a modern foreign language at GCSE should also broaden

students' horizons and encourage them to step beyond familiar cultural boundaries

and develop new ways of seeing the world.

Learning a language really helps to develop the following skills- Problem solving, building confidence, time management, self organisation, learning Grammar both in the target language and in English. It helps the learner to develop an appreciation for the wider world and a love of travelling and different cultures.
