Dear Parent/Carer,

Most of the students at CoDA wear the correct uniform every day. There are however a small number of students who have recently not been wearing the correct and complete uniform. So, and continuing our drive for excellence and for the best routines that support the strongest learning, I wish to remind all students and parents of our uniform expectations.

All students must wear:

A plain white shirt with collar (no polo or t-shirts)

A school tie

Smart black trousers or skirt (tops of trousers and skirts worn to the waist, of sensible length and not stretchy material)

A black V-neck jumper and/or school blazer (no hoodies or sweatshirts)

Sensible black school footwear.

Under no circumstances are hoodies allowed in school and any coats must be plain black, with no obvious (large) branding or logos.

We will be reminding students of our expectations in assemblies during Thursday 12th and Friday 13th March and will expect all students to adhere to uniform expectations from Monday 16th March. To reassure everyone, these uniform regulations are not new, we are merely reminding our students of the expectations that have been in place for some time now.

From Monday 16th March, any student not in full and correct uniform will be stopped at the school gate and directed through to one of our halls, where they will be given new correct uniform from our uniform shop. Parents will then be contacted to arrange for payment. Any items of non-school uniform (for example hoodies and sweatshirts) will be confiscated and held until the end of the day, when they will be returned to the student to take home. If items of outer wear are repeatedly confiscated, these items will be returned to the parents only and by prior appointment, rather than to the student.

We are immensely grateful for your support in ensuring all students are dressed correctly for school.
